

Newsletter (2) for the 2009 Bondi Rugby Tens Tournament



- Welcome to another Newsletter of the fifth **Bondi 10's Rugby Tournament**, to be held on **13th & 14th February 2009**. The Tournament will be played at the Woollahra Colleagues Rugby Football Club, Woollahra Playing fields, Manion Avenue, Rose Bay, Sydney. - Every player must be insured for participation in the tournament before he sets foot on the field. Last year there were two ways of being insured
 1. Having current registration with a club affiliated with the ARU (if you played in the 2008 season your registration/insurance would be valid to 1 march 2009)
 2. If you did not have current registration you could purchase cover for the tournament for \$10.

We are discussing with ARU alternative modes of insurance and we will let you know if there is any change.
